Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi wants your collegiate experience to be a positive one. The University believes you have the potential to succeed in college. While we cannot offer you Full Admission at this time, we want to extend the opportunity for you to be admitted conditionally. Conditional Admission offers you the benefits of a prescribed first year course of study with additional academic support and careful structured monitoring to ensure your success through your freshman year.

To be granted CONDITIONAL ADMISSION to the University, you must agree to the following expectations:

1. While on Conditional Admission, you will be limited to a maximum of 15 hours of enrollment per semester. Exceptions may be made for specific academic programs.
2. You are expected to enroll in all required courses as determined by your TSI, ACT, SAT, high school GPA, high school class rank, high school transcript results, and your Academic Advisor.
3. As a conditional admit you will be expected to work with the Academic Coaching Program in the Center for Academic Student Achievement (CASA). You will be assigned an Academic Success Coach to assist you in your transition to college and guide you to complete the requirements for full admission.

By agreeing to these conditions, you are agreeing to additional support and benefits that will lay the foundation for your future academic success at TAMUCC and beyond.

**NOTE:** Some degree programs, financial services, or other activities may require additional admission standards that must be met to gain admission to specified programs. For more information, please contact your advisor.

**Completing your conditions:**

Students with conditional admittance have a CN hold placed on their account. Each semester, the CN hold will be temporarily lifted by the Academic Coaching Program based on an assessment of each semester progress to allow you to register for the upcoming semester. You will be transitioned into unconditional admittance and the CN hold will be permanently removed when you have met the following conditions:

- Satisfactorily completed the prescribed course of study and conditions outlined above.
- Earned at least a 2.0 institutional GPA and maintain good satisfactory academic progress for financial aid on your first 30 hours completed.

Your journey begins here and does not just end with a degree. You will always be a part of the University family and will encounter countless opportunities on your path towards success. TAMUCC clears your way and ensures your time and money here are well spent. This agreement between you and TAMUCC is a commitment to your future. We will be by your side, supporting you every step of the way.
