

USING RESPONDUS LOCKDOWN BROWSER WITH DIFFERENT INSTITUTIONS

The Respondus Lockdown Browser (LDB) is uniquely coded for the institution it was licensed for so it's vital that you use the correct one for a corresponding institution.

No Pre-existing LDB Installation

If you are a 3rd party entity (e.g., a testing center) needing the Respondus lockdown browser licensed for TAMU-CC and do not already have a LDB installation:

- Download it from <https://www.respondus.com/lockdown/download.php?id=797913747>.
- Follow the installation guide to completion.

Pre-Existing LDB Installation(s)

If you are a student, or a 3rd party entity, and already have the Respondus Lockdown Browser installed on your system for an institution other than TAMU-CC:

- Download and install the LDB again from <https://www.respondus.com/lockdown/download.php?id=797913747>.
- A pop-up window will appear alerting you that the browser is already installed. Click the "**Yes**" to install another version.
- After clicking the "**Yes**" button a second pop-up giving the option to "Install Lockdown Browser for a Second Institution" will be presented. Select this option and click the "**Next**" button.
- The rest of the installation will happen automatically and a new "Lockdown Browser (2)" shortcut be added to the desktop as well as in the Start Menu under Start>Programs>Respondus.
- It is strongly suggested that the shortcuts for all LDB installations be renamed appropriately for the institution associated with the installation (e.g. TAMUCC-LDB, UNIXYZ-LDB, etc.).
