I'm an Associate Professor of Chemistry at Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi specializing in organic geochemist; I got my Ph.D. in Chemical Oceanography from Old Dominion University, for the last 12 years I've been using the chemical characterization of natural complex mixtures organic compounds to identify the chemical clues that left behind after different biotic or abiotic processes, to track the sources of these organic compounds, and how these natural organic compounds affect the solubility of anthropogenic pollutants.




Research Interests



My research interests focus on studying the fate of terrestrial dissolved organic matter (tDOM) as it moves to the open ocean, and how major removal processes (photochemical, microbial oxidation and flocculation) are mineralizing and modifying the chemical structures of tDOM. I am also investigating how the microbial and aquatic species communities respond and tolerate environmental stresses by studying the changes in their metabolomics profiles (both targeted and untargeted metabolites).







