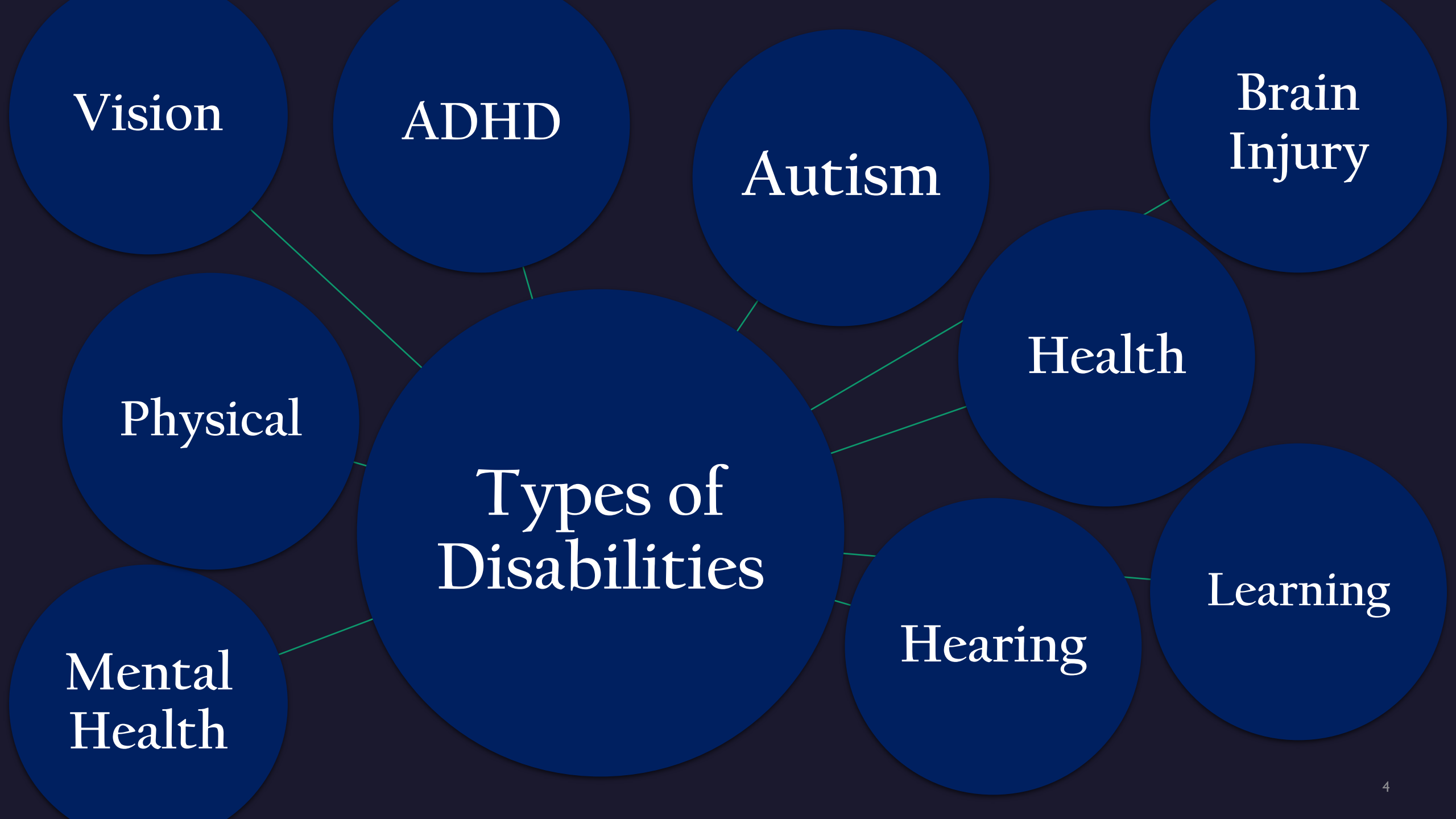
Accommodations -- Our Obligation

LEGAL

- The Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Section 504 of the Rehab Act
- Colleges required to provide “reasonable accommodations” UNLESS
 - Financial burden
 - Fundamental alteration of the course
