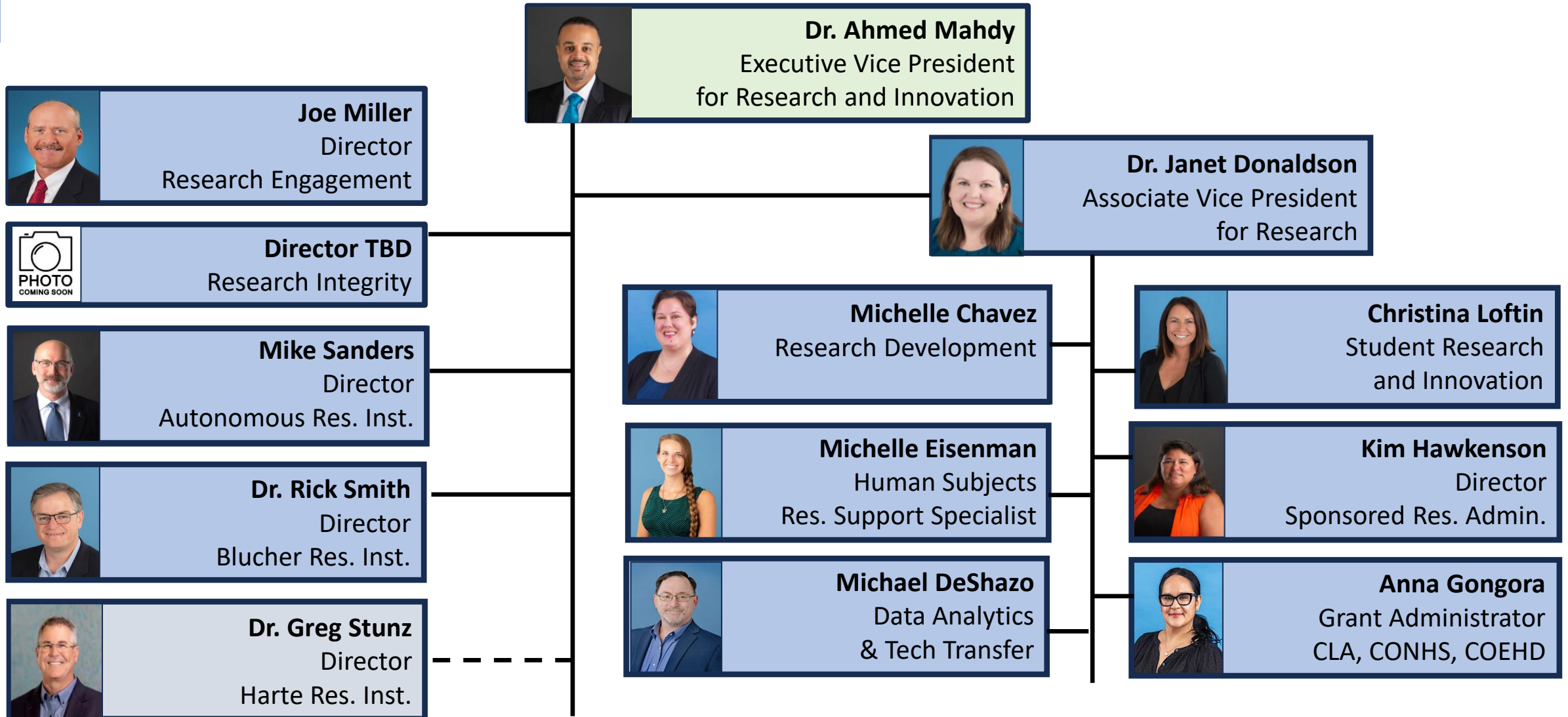

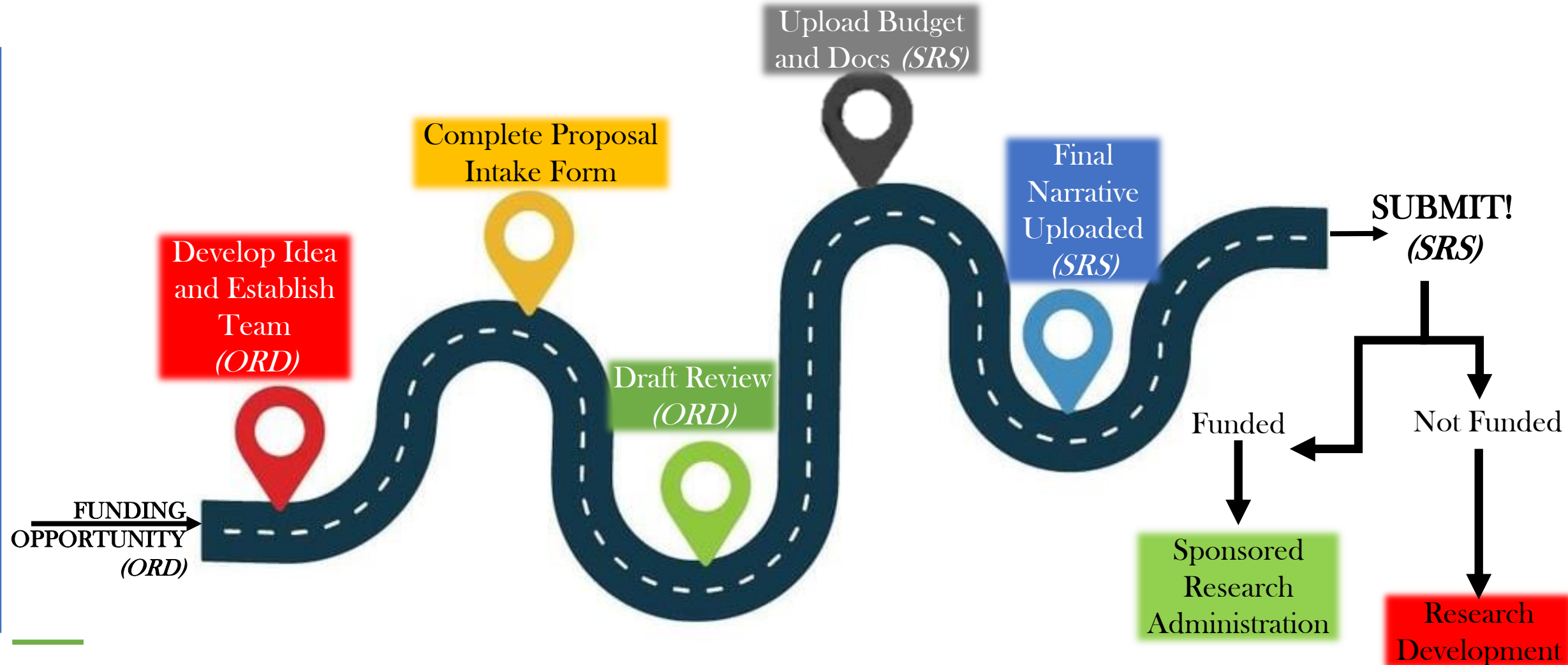

The Proposal Intake Form is your primary tool for initiating communication with Sponsored Research Services (SRS), the Division of Research and Innovation, and your College/Institute regarding upcoming proposal submissions. Upon submission, the form will be automatically routed to your designated SRS administrator, who will guide you through the next steps of the grant process. The information will also be shared with the Office of Research Development, your Dean/Director, and your unit's Research Administrator to streamline communication and enhance support for your proposal's development.

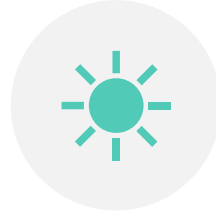

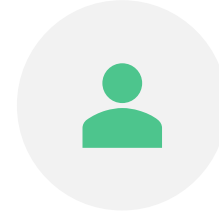
