On September 7, students in the Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi (TAMU-CC) HSI STEM Operation Success (SOS) Collegiate STEM Institute (CSI) summer bridge program participated in an inspiring team-building activity on North Padre Island, where they learned to surf with the help of the university's Rec Sports Outdoor Adventures team.



This event was part of the bridge program's comprehensive approach to preparing students for college by fostering community, belonging, and teamwork. The four-week virtual summer program, federally funded by the HSI ED office, supports incoming students identified as underrepresented.

These students are from all over Texas and have been accepted as TAMU-CC students for the fall 2024 semester. They are provided with educational and enrichment activities before arriving on campus, upon which they participate in STEM and support activities throughout the school year. By combining academic preparation with personal development activities, the program ensures that students are better prepared for the demands of college life.
